

PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of the SH 178 (Artcraft Road) Project is to improve safety and reliability of travel time. The project limits are SH 178 (Artcraft Road) between the New Mexico State line and I-10. Local and long-distance freight drivers would benefit from the proposed project, including trucks traveling to/from the Union Pacific Railroad Intermodal Facility and the Santa Teresa Port of Entry.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Proposed operational improvements include four direct connectors at the interchange of I-10 and SH 178. The proposed three two-lane and one singe-lane direct connectors are based on a preliminary phase of schematic design. The final determination of lanes for each direct connector will come after a traffic analysis is complete.

On SH 178 between I-10 and SH 20 (Doniphan Drive), proposed improvements include access control measures, reconstruction, and extending frontage roads in both directions.

Two intersecting streets, Upper Valley Road and Westside Drive, are increasingly congested due to new development. Grade separated interchanges are planned with four elevated lanes over these streets, as well as entrance and exit ramps to SH 178.

Right-of-way acquisition is anticipated.

Currently, NM 136 and SH 178 is the only roadway connecting the Santa Teresa-San Jeronimo Border Crossing to the United States National Freight Network of I-10.

- Facilitates movement of oversized loads through the I-10/ SH 178 interchange.


Reduces Barriers to Employment Centers
